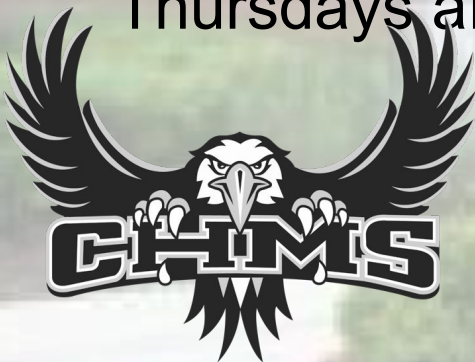

Commitment forms were sent home with students at the first meeting. Yearbook club meets on Thursdays after school until spring break.

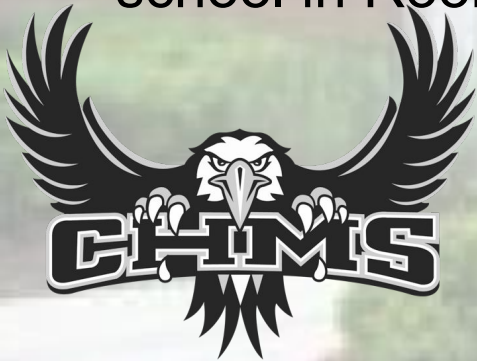
